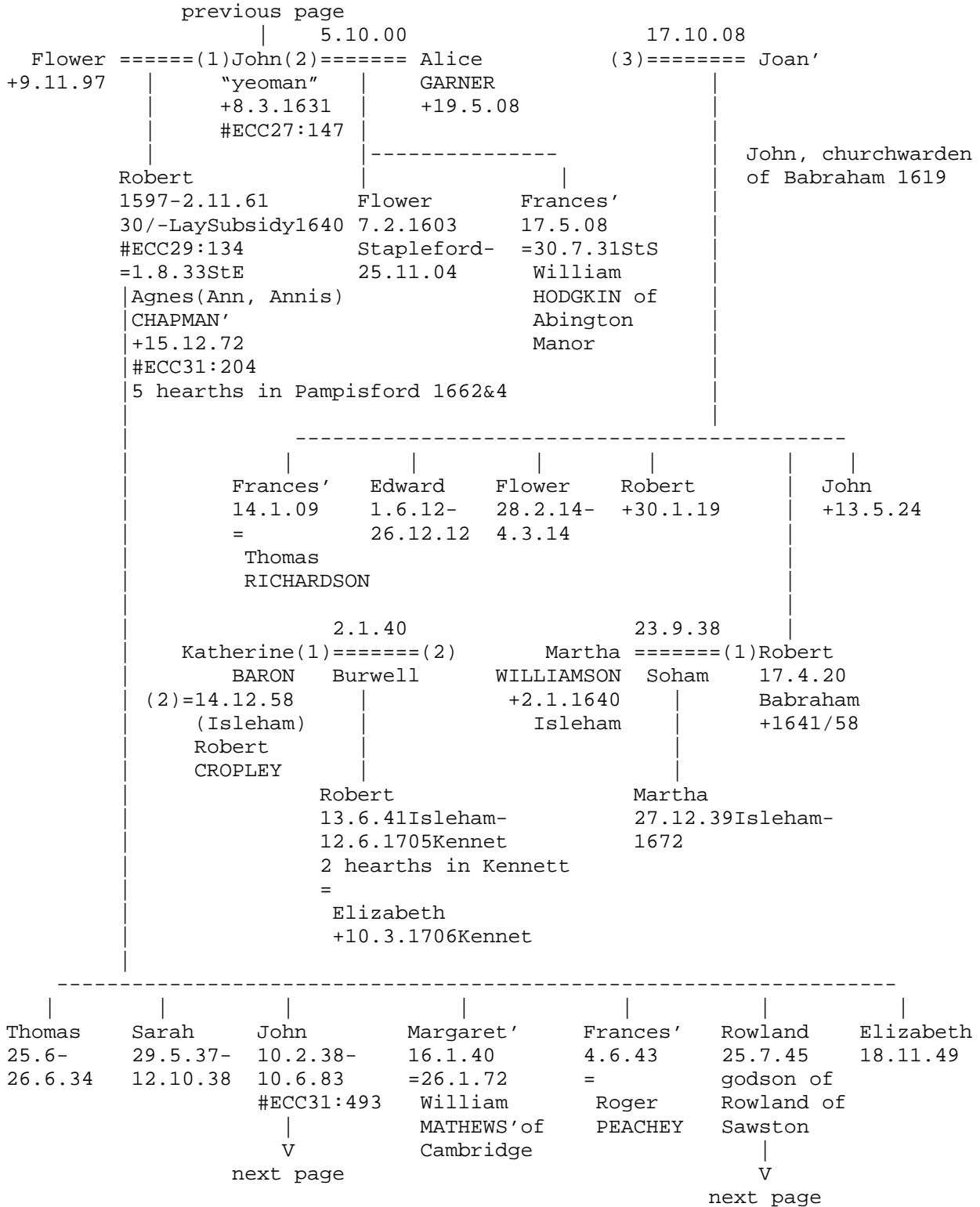

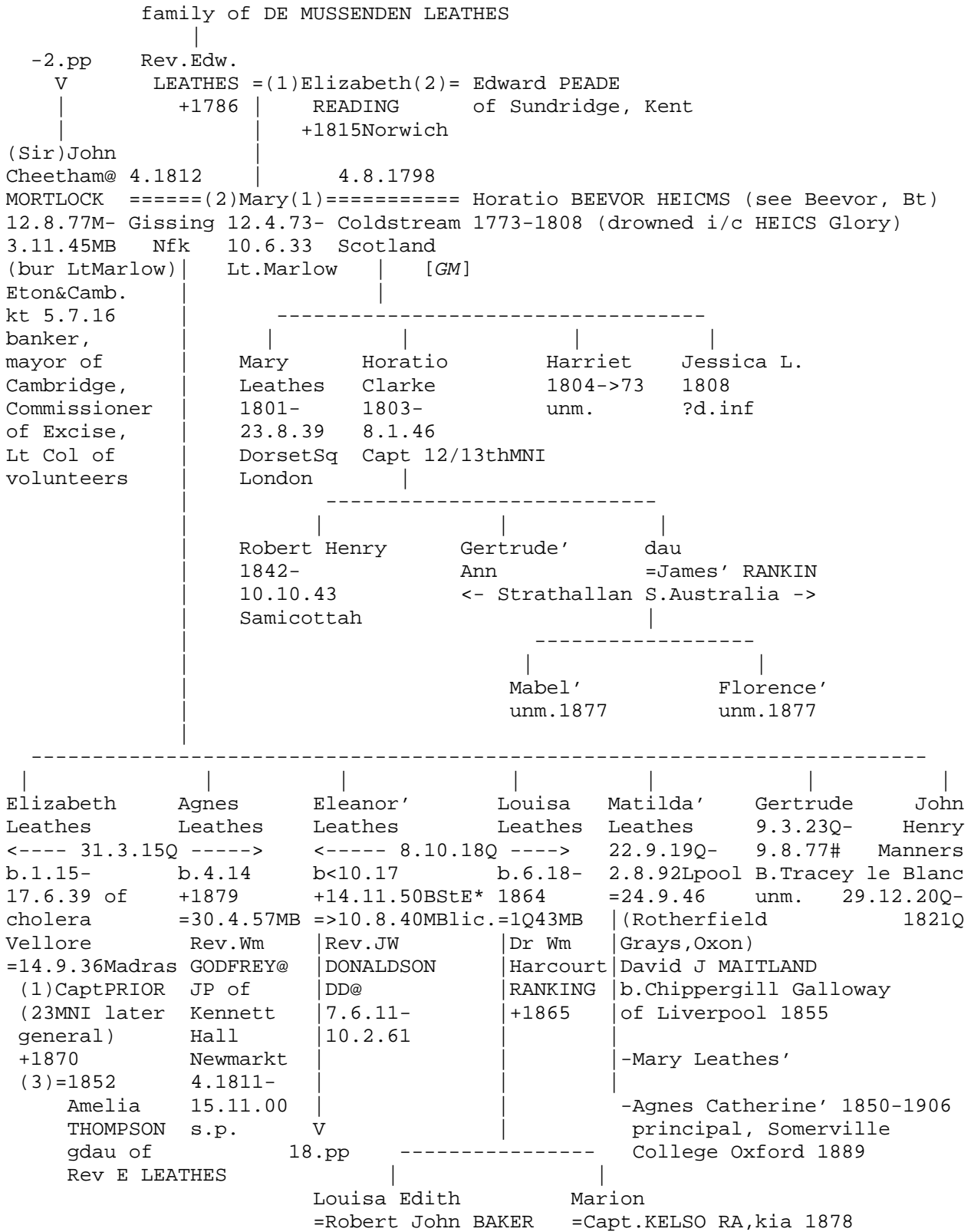

In 1935-36 he played for a Brighton Students team in the county team championship. After World War II he does not seem to have been such an active player, though [he played] on a high board for the county. He was still playing for Sussex in 1966, but .. this was close to the end of his county chess career." Percy Finch Mortlock went to sea (MN apprentice 16.3.1891 London) (where he got himself tattooed on the forearms), including two trips to Sydney in 1893 (ordinary seaman Killarney Newcastle NSW -> Auckland & Lyttleton NZ 1892), and then in London in April 1895 enlisted in the Royal Artillery. After serving in Gosport, Portsmouth and the Isle of Wight he bought himself out for £18 in September 1897 [TNA,W097/3509]. See also TNA,W0363/M2030. 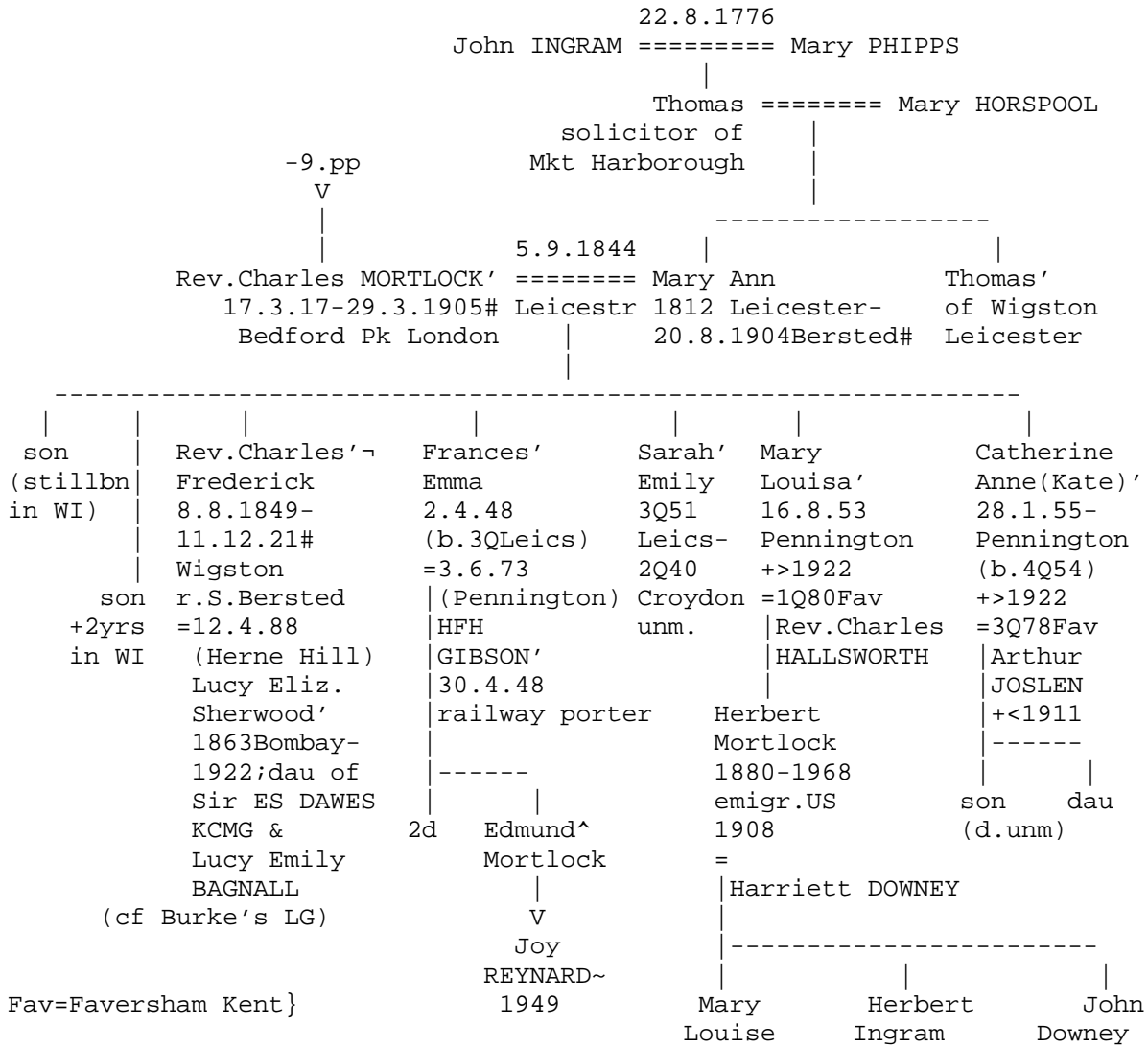

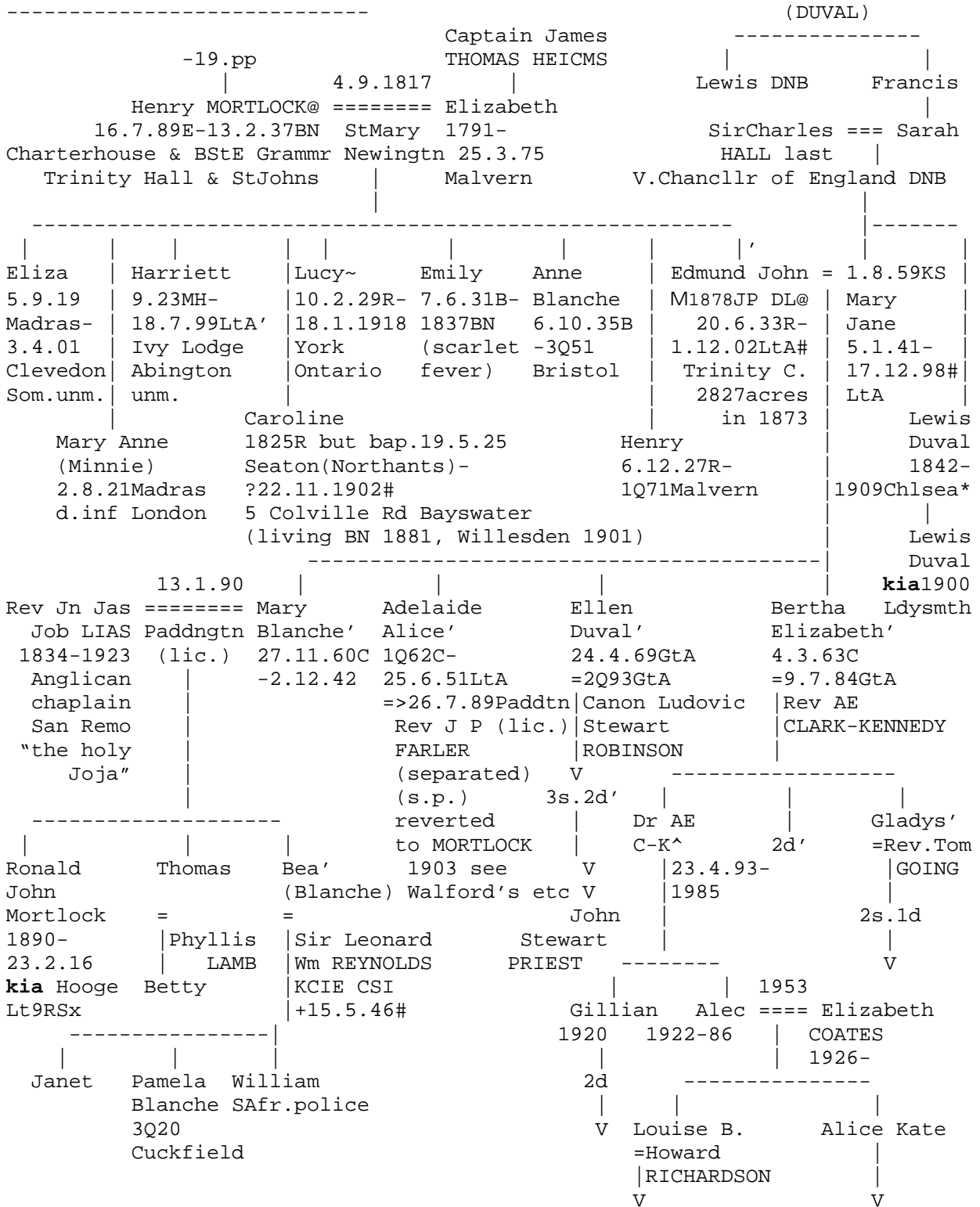
