Julia came to France and took care of Alice's sons. See Peter Andrew Fontanille-Mortlock's post on the Mortlock website. Date of death here, however (at 5 Rue St Denis, Nanterre) is from the original French record. Julia d.Havre 1.9.1918 [PRO, RG35/44 p.562].

WWCM and Elizabeth and the first four of this family, presumably after failing to make things stick in Lincolnshire, tried their luck first in the US, arriving Boston 8.8.70 in the *Tripoli* of Glasgow, and then in Australia, arriving November 1881 aboard the *Norfolk*. However, clearly this didn't work, and, after a throw at East Ham, 1884 sees them in Beckenham, Kent, as above.
