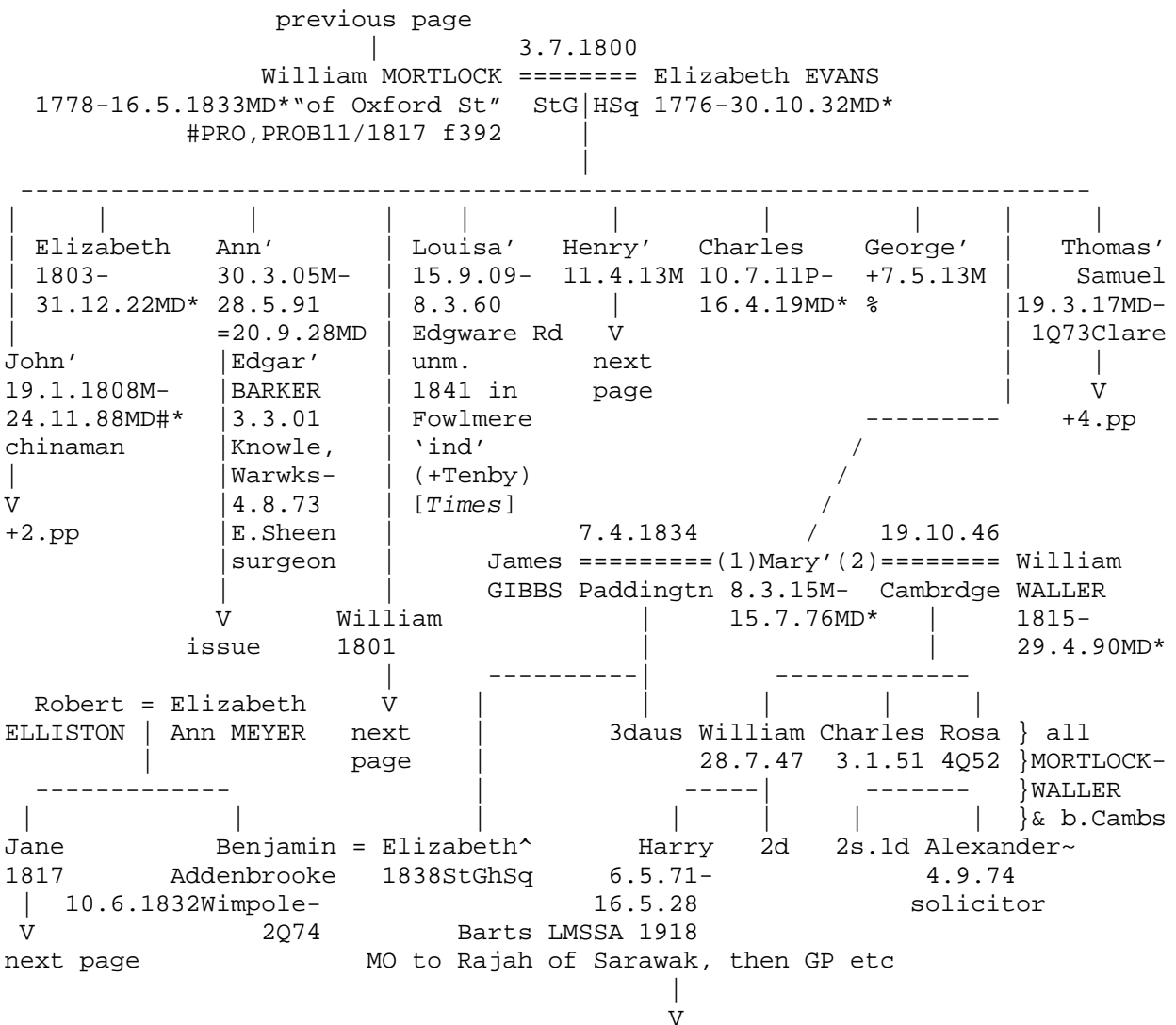

- handwriting on codicil (signed JM of Cambridge) attested by Simon STURGES, china dealer. JM had a run of 7 houses in Regency Square, Brighton, and property called The Old Ball Room on the south side of Cheltenham High St. "From the funds arising from the grant of waste lands, the moiety of the rent of Wormholt Wood, as held on lease by Government, and the liberality and munificence of John Mortlock, Esq. who resided at Shepherd's Bush, and built two houses at his own expense, [nine] Almshouses, were finished ... 1813." [History & Antiquities of Hammersmith, Thomas Faulkner, 1839 (Google Books)] which also describes him as 'the eminent china-man of Oxford St'. See also *Morning Chronicle*, 25.9.38 for John's founding a servants' asylum.

^ Louisa Woodd MORTLOCK was a precocious and saintly child who was three years a-dying of fever following measles in 1817. There is a short biography of her in the British Library.

@ this marriage is also recorded as taking place in Agogna, Turin, to Caesar Jean Solomon MALAN. Solomon Caesar Malan was in court seeking the transfer to him of Bank of England stock in the name of his late wife and her father in 1860 [Times, 20.11.60]. He was a noted orientalist; his sketch books were featured in *Connoisseur* October 1968.

PRO,TS11/177 gives details of the lawsuit of WOODE and MALAN (infants) versus William MARSH re the will of John MORTLOCK of Regency Square, Brighton.

Julia kept Maud with her for several years, then put her on the train from London and sent her to Jeanette in Coventry, who brought her up with her own brood, although Maud always felt she was a bit of a poor relation. In time, Maud herself got pregnant and married. She and her husband (MIDDLETON), with their young daughter, emigrated to Australia in 1927 and their descendants are still there. For the avoidance of doubt, Maud died some years ago in South Australia. There was no birth certificate among her belongings. Her daughter, now also deceased, did not remember ever seeing one.
